Educational Psychology Support for Individual Children and Young People

Option 1: A Virtual Drop-In

Aim: To unpick complex presentations of need and main concerns. To provide verbal practical advice and next steps during the drop-in.

Report options and costs

- 1 hour Drop-in with verbal advice: £122
- 1 hour Drop-in and Action Plan (2 hours): £366
- 1 hour Drop-in and Summary Report (3 hours): £488


Option 2: Consultation Day

Aim: Schools can select the degree of consultation support based on the level of concern and the depth of understanding required around a child or young person's needs. A 'light-touch' consultation day allows for discussion of up to four children, with Action Plans developed for each. Alternatively, schools may choose to focus on two children, enabling a more in-depth exploration of their presenting needs.

Discussing between three or four children enables a greater number of students being supported within our time in school and increases the reach of our psychological support across a whole school. However, supporting fewer children in a consultation day increases the amount of professional involvement we can offer and allows for more detailed formulations and informed Action Plans.

We offer this flexible model as it enables schools to plan the level of our support, ensuring it aligns with the needs of their children as well as the resources available within their budgets.

Examples of consultation days include:

- For four children: Four consultations and Action Plans devised with school staff.
- For three children: Three consultations with staff and Action Plans devised with school staff, informed by brief observations of each child.
- For two children: Half a day per child to complete consultations with staff and Action Plans, informed by either a consultation with parents or carers and brief observation, or the completion of assessments/pupil voice (depending upon priorities and needs).

Cost: £670 (Service Level Agreement (SLA) schools) or £690 (one-off support).

Action Plans will be devised verbally during the consultation days. Schools can later decide whether they would like to opt for their Action Plans to be written up into a report.

Report options and costs

Schools can select from a range of report formats following a consultation day, depending on the degree of our involvement and the amount of detail required.

For consultation days that discussed three or four children:

- Action Plans: (2 hours) £237 each (SLA schools) or £243 each (one-off support).
- Summary Reports: (3 hours) £355 each (SLA school) or £365 each (one-off support).

For consultation days that discussed two children:

- Summary Reports: (3 hours) £355 (SLA school) or £365 (one-off support).
- Psychological Reports (1 day - Reports, inclusive of assessment results summaries): £670 each (SLA school) or £690 each (one-off support).




Option 3 Psychological Advice and Reports

When a child or young person presents with complex needs and a full psychological assessment and advice is required, we can carry out a one-day school visit. This allows us to gather the depth of information needed to produce detailed and comprehensive psychological advice.

The 1-day school visit would be inclusive of:

- Consultations with staff.
- Consultations with parents or carers.
- Consultations with other professionals (if required).
- Completion of assessments.
- A therapeutic conversation with the child or young person.
- Consolidation of any additional information within a child or young person's school file, including other professional reports.



Cost: £670 (Service Level Agreement (SLA) schools) or £690 (one-off support).

Report options and costs

- Psychological Report (1 day): £670 each (SLA school) or £690 each (one-off support).
- Psychological Report (1.5 day): £1,025 (SLA School) or £1,055 (one-off support).
- Full Psychological Advice (2 days and equivalent to a Statutory Assessment Report): £1,340 (SLA school) or £1,380 (one-off support).

The variation in report size reflects the degree of detail included within each report.
